

All New F-1 International Students Must Enroll in a Hybrid or Face-to-face Credit and must:

- 1. Log in to your *my*UMBC profile and check your COVID-19 compliance card to see if you are approved for campus access;
- 2. Take a COVID-19 test and report a negative result;
- 3. Complete daily online symptom tracking throughout the semester; AND
- 4. Complete an online health and safety training module.
- 5. Students living and/or taking classes on campus are also required to sign the **Retriever Community Agreement** making a personal commitment to precautions and actions required in order to minimize the potential spread of COVID-19 on our campus and beyond.
