What is RIH?

- Retriever Integrated Health was established in 2021 when University Health Services, Counseling Center, and Health Promotions joined as one unit to support the well-being and success of the UMBC community.
- The staff work together to provide services in the area of clinical services, health promotion initiatives, and outreach.



Where can I find RIH?

- Building name is called
 Center for Well-Being
- Two story, newly constructed building
- Located on Center Rd
- Between Chesapeake Hall and Susquehanna Hall
- 2nd Floor- Health and Counseling are located





What services does RIH offer?

- Services offered for health includes but not limited to:
 - Primary Care: Physicals, Sick Visits, Address Concerns
 - Urgent Care: Minor Injuries and Same Day appointments
 - Gynecological Services: Examinations, Birth Control, Pregnancy Testing
 - Lab Services: TB Screening, STI Testing, Urine test, strep, mono, and rapid COVID
 - Immunizations: MMR, HEP B, Meningitis, Tdap (tetanus), Gardasil (HPV)
 - Allergy Injections under the direction from allergist
 - Massage Therapy and Acupuncture
 - Pharmacy Service: Prescription Dispensary on site or ability to have prescriptions delivered to RIH from outside pharmacy (AME, Rite Aid, and Catonsville Pharmacy)



Insurance

- As international students, insurance is required
- Aetna is the school sponsored provider
- Students have a choice to waive Aetna with only ISO
- View plans in its entirety at <u>www.aetnastudenthealth.com</u> and select UMBC Graduate or UMBC (undergraduate plan), then select "view my plan"



Choice in Aetna plans (Self Insured)

- Graduate Plan
 - Must be a graduate student
 - Includes dental coverage
 - No deductible
 - No referral needed
 - If UHS is used, covers 100% after copay
 - Plan pays 80%, Student pays 20% of in-network services, after copay
 - Copay: \$10 for primary care,\$20 for specialist
 - Cost: Spring Semester- \$2838

- Undergraduate Plan
 - No dental coverage
 - \$550 deductible
 - Reduced to \$350 if RIH is primary doctor or referral is obtained
 - If UHS is used, covers 100% after copay
 - Plan pays 80%, Student pays 20% of in-network services, after copay
 - Copay: \$10 for primary, \$20 for specialist
 - Cost: Spring Semester- \$1652



How do I get my Aetna card?

- If you had a local address, the hard copy will be mailed
- If you didn't have a local address at the time of enrollment, card is mailed to RIH and notified when it arrives
- Download/Printing option
 - www.aetnastudenthealth.com
 - Select UMBC Graduate or UMBC (Undergraduate Plan)
 - Select "Get my ID card"
 - 10-digit account number (upper left corner of tuition bill)
 - Date of birth



What if I want to waive Aetna?

- Waivers are ONLY accepted in August of each academic year
- Plan must provide coverage from August 2021 through June 2022
- If entering UMBC for the first time in the spring semester, coverage must be from January 2022 through June 2022, DO NOT TAKE COVEAGE FOR A YEAR AT THIS TIME
- ISO is the most common to waive and offers two UMBC plans
- Domestic plans can be used however repatriation coverage must be purchased in addition to satisfy the waiver requirements
- Coverages must meet or exceed requirements which can be found in detail on RIH website
- Must include pre-existing conditions
- Travel policies are NOT accepted
- Strongly urge to compare plans



What if I want to waive Aetna?

- Completing waiver
 - Log into myretrievercare.umbc.edu
 - Choose insurance waiver
 - Enter all information about your insurance: policy number, group number, address to file claims, etc
 - Upload insurance card and confirmation letter that shows coverage from January 2022 through June 2022
 - NO EMAIL OR PAPER COPIES accepted, all waivers
 MUST be through myretrievercare.umbc.edu
 - Must be completed by February 15, 2022


Student secured health portal used to communicate with providers and staff, obtain medical records, submit required documents
